

Just Us League has run monthly robotics meets since January 2025

Just Us League acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we meet in the Illawarra, and pays respects to Elders past and present. We pay our respects to all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who join our programs.

The Just Us League Limited is a registered charity in Wollongong. Since January 2025 we've held a robotics and AI meet every month for families in the Illawarra. We do it at Berkeley Community Hall. There's no charge. A parent or carer stays and works with their kids. It isn't a drop-off, and you don't need to know robots before you walk in. Kids are welcome.

On the tables you'll find a mix of things, on purpose. LEGO robotics for the people who like bricks. VEX IQ for the ones who want a robot on a proper field. Simple wooden robots that run on batteries (we call those Single Use Robots). And STEM games, including Spintronics, which is circuits made of gears, and Turing Tumble, which is a marble run that behaves like a tiny computer. Families pick what they want to try. Nobody has to do all of it.

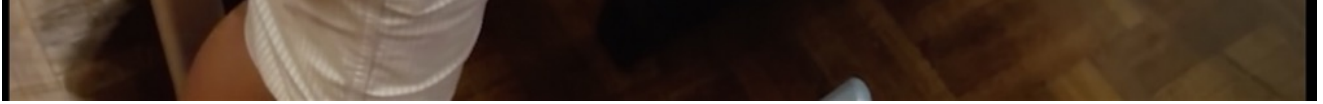
The gear in the hall stays with the charity so it's there again next month. That's separate from the kits we give away.
